1. All officers must have and maintain a 2.5 cumulative and/or semester SDSU GPA and remain in good judicial standing with the university throughout their term of office.
2. All officers must attend the Executive Board and Delegate meetings on Mondays from 1:00-3:00 pm.
3. All officers must be active (not alumni) members in good standing with their chapter throughout their term of office.
4. The membership recruitment team members are expected to remain in San Diego throughout the summer to assist with fall membership recruitment. All other officers are expected to reside in San Diego from August 15 until the end of the summer to be available to assist with fall membership recruitment.
5. The President, Vice President, Activities Director, and the Recruitment Director are required to attend the AFLV-West Conference in Orange County which is held in April.
